# **1 OVERVIEW**




Figure 1: Division across countries of the host institutions of the workshop organizers

The workshop track of the Web Conference 2023 organized 20 workshops (12 full-day workshops, 8 half-day workshops) in Austin, Texas, United States. The workshop track hosted organizers from 82 unique institutions (56 of which are universities) located in 20 countries, as can be seen in Figure 1. The workshop program consisted of a mixture of both new and established workshops, with 7 workshops being organized for the first time.

Following the successful approach of previous years, the workshop programs consisted of a combination of (long) research papers, (short) vision, work-in-progress and/or demo papers, keynote speakers, and panel & community discussions. In total 118 papers were accepted across all workshops.
